Dear Bishoprics and Youth Leaders,

Thanks for your support of this year's Stake Youth Conference. We are planning some great activities, and look forward to being with the youth and youth leaders in August!

The Stake Youth Conference Transportation Committee has decided to have each ward be responsible for transporting the youth from their ward to and from JR Properties, the site for this year's Stake Youth Conference.

We would request that you understand and comply with the guidelines in the attached letter from the Church Priesthood Department entitled "Safety Guidelines for Activities." Please ensure all adults attending this activity are also made aware of these guidelines.

All vehicles **MUST** be covered by a public liability and property damage liability insurance policy. The amount of this coverage must meet or exceed the insurance requirement of the state in which the vehicle is licensed. The minimum requirement for the state of Utah is \$25,000 per person for bodily injury, \$50,000 per accident for bodily injury, and \$15,000 per accident for property.

Please assign each camp participant to a vehicle for transportation and emergency evacuation use. Please feel free to use the attached sheet. When this sheet is complete, please return one copy to John Dye (dyejo@yahoo.com; 631-4736) for stake records. Please return it no later than July 20.

Finally, attached you will also find all attendees (youth and leaders) that have completed and submitted an application form to the stake. If anyone from your ward is planning to attend and their name does not appear on this list, make sure they speak with a member of your ward's Young Men or Young Women Presidency to get an application submitted ASAP.

7. Ensure that at least two adult supervisors are present at an activity. For overnight outings involving young women, two or more Melchizedek Priesthood brethren should be present in addition to female adult leaders.
8. Use the buddy system for hiking, camping, and aquatics activities.
9. Parents, including those who are leaders, are not to take their younger children on Church-sponsored youth activities.
10. Notify the bishop and stake president promptly if an accident, illness, or injury occurs on Church property or during a Church-sponsored activity. Bishops and stake presidents should notify the Risk Management Division at Church headquarters if the accident involves serious injury (telephone 1-801-240-4049).

Safety training is also available to Scouting leaders through local Scouting-sponsored meetings.
